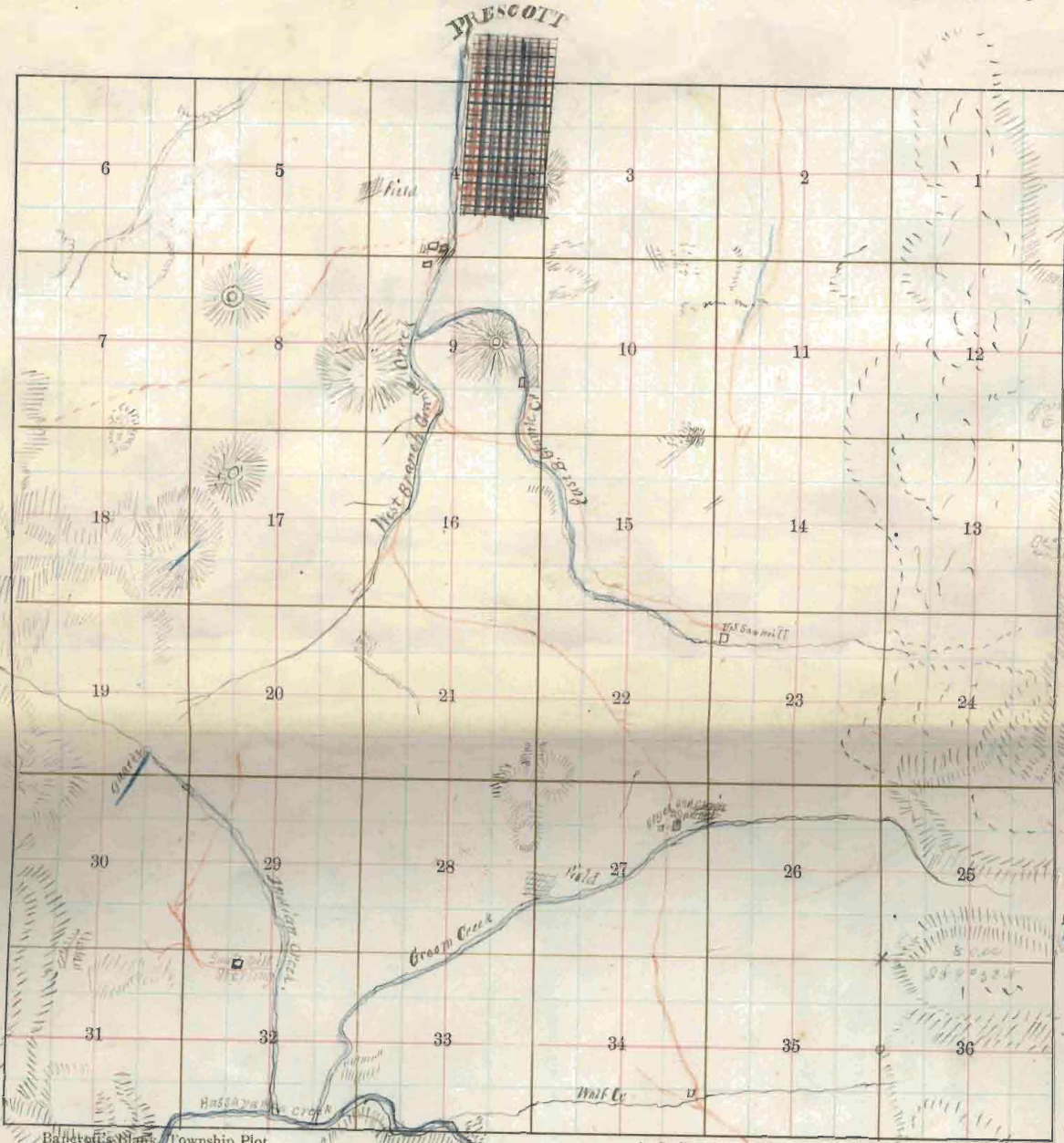

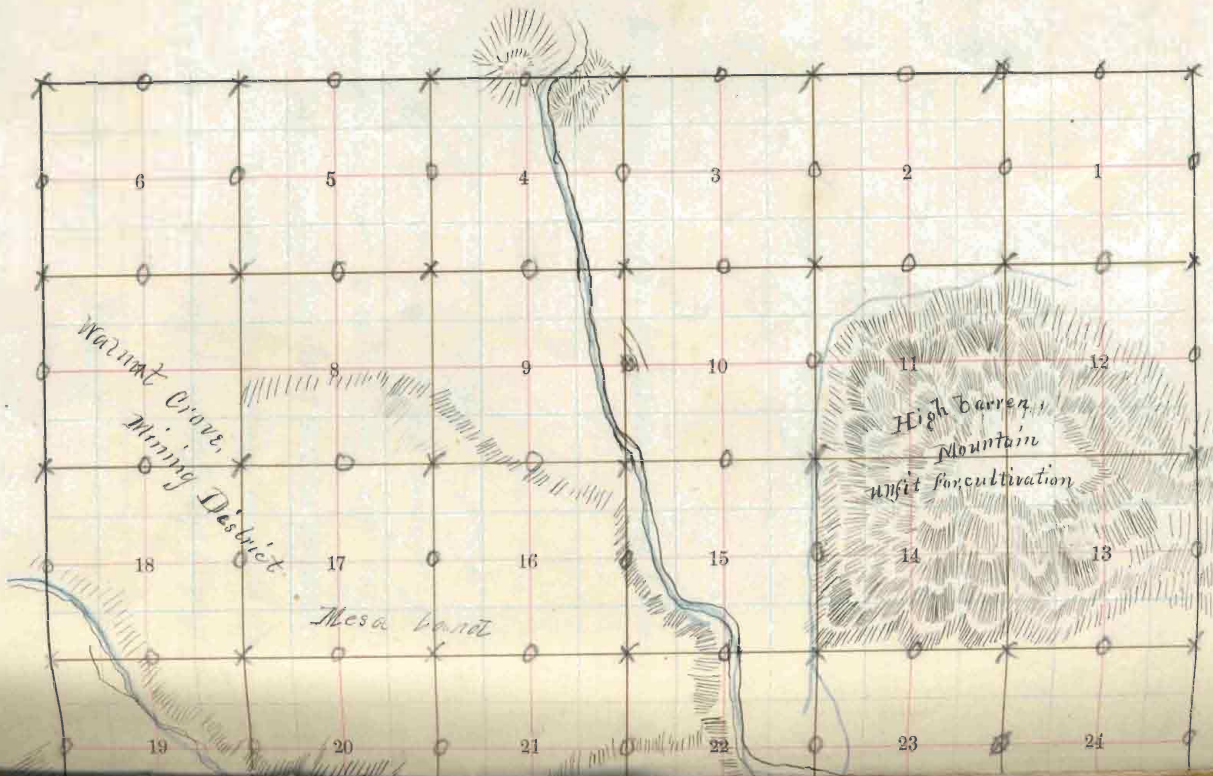
This Township contains some
