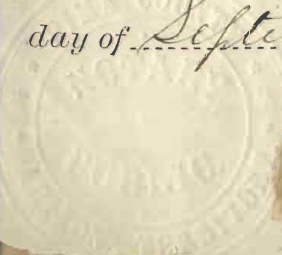

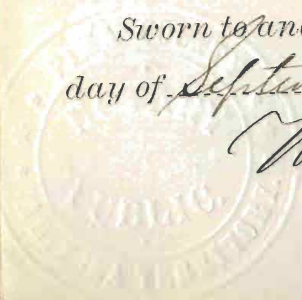

General Description
