CHAINS

Sections 3 and 4

Township 22 South, Range 22 East, Arizona

The north boundary of sections 3 and 4 was surveyed in 1909 by J. B. Wright. The west boundary of section 4 is the east boundary of the San Rafael Del Valle Private Land Claim and was surveyed in 1879 by S. M. Allis and retraced in 1916 by S. E. Blout. The remaining boundaries of sections 3 and 4 were surveyed in 1916 by S. E. Blout.

The following notes are those of a dependent resurvey of the boundaries and a survey of subdivisions, sections 3 and 4, Township 22 South, Range 22 East, Gila and Salt River Meridian, Arizona.

This survey was executed in accordance with the specifications as set forth in the Manual of Surveying Instructions, 1947, and the Special Instructions dated April 4, 1963.

Bathey Markers described herein are "T" iron stakes, 24 inches long, with aluminum caps.

Only the true line bearings and horizontal distances for the surveyed lines are given in these notes.

The geographic position of the southeast corner of section 3 is: Latitude 31°32'26.5" N., and Longitude 110°05'15.9" W.

The magnetic declination was found to be 13°00' East.
