	<p>Township 41 North, Range 11 West Gila and Salt River Meridian, Arizona</p> <hr/> <p>The south boundary, which is the Tenth Standard Parallel North, was surveyed in 1939 by Muscott, Warner and Motch. The west boundary was surveyed in 1921 by J. P. Davis and dependently resurveyed in 1956 by P. K. Russell. The north and east boundaries were surveyed in 1956 by P. K. Russell.</p> <p>The following notes describe a survey of the subdivisional lines of Township 41 North, Range 11 West, Gila and Salt River Meridian, Arizona.</p> <p>This survey was executed in accordance with the specifications as set forth in the Manual of Surveying Instructions, 1947, and the Special Instructions dated June 22, 1962.</p> <p>Only the true line bearings and horizontal distances for the surveyed lines are given in these notes. Dutchman Draw, Quail Draw and their tributaries drain the township northerly, emptying into Fort Pierce Wash.</p>

CHAINS

The elevation varies from about 4850 feet above sea level in section 31 to 2800 feet above sea level in sections 2 and 6. Sunshine Trail extends southerly through the eastern part of the township with several roads branching off to water holes and mineral locations. A blade road with numerous side roads branching off extends northeasterly through the township along the base of the mountains.

There is fair grass and undergrowth at the higher elevations with livestock grazing being the present predominating interest. No active mining was noted in the township, although many location markers were in evidence.
