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CHAINS

The south boundary was surveyed in 1875 by C. B. Foster and dependently resurveyed in 1882 by O. D. Wheeler. The boundary was retraced in 1944 by Forrest and Warner. The north, east and west boundaries and the subdivisional lines were surveyed in 1882 by O. D. Wheeler.

The following notes are those of a dependent resurvey of the south, east, north and west boundaries and the subdivisional lines of Township 15 North, Range 26 East, Gila and Salt River Meridian, Arizona.

This survey was executed in accordance with the specifications as set forth in the Manual of Surveying Instructions, 1947, and the Special Instructions dated March 13, 1963.

Only the true line bearings and horizontal distances for the surveyed lines are given in these field notes. Unless described, each corner was monumented with a standard iron post 30 inches long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ inches diameter, flanged at the base and with a brass cap riveted to the top. Original corner monuments, unless described otherwise, were deposited alongside the new monuments.

The geographic position of the southeast corner of the township is: Latitude, $34^{\circ}39'37''$ North, and Longitude, $109^{\circ}31'37.9''$ West.

The magnetic declination was found to be 14° East.

	The land in Township 15 North, Range 26 East, varies from nearly level range land to rolling clay hills cut by deep gullies to steep and broken North Mountain. The soil is mostly clay loam and clay hardpan, with sand on the mesas and sandy clay on the nearly level range land. Moderate junipers are found in the northeast corner of the township, extending southwesterly along the higher elevations. The grazing of livestock is the primary interest as there is good grass throughout the township. Windmills and reservoirs afford a continual water supply. Only a small percentage of the original corners were found during this survey (usually where the terrain was rough), due partly to the time elapsed since the original survey and, according to some local sources, corners were purposely removed and destroyed by some of the early settlers. All evidence such as bearing trees and buildings given in the original survey notes seems to have been thoroughly removed.
