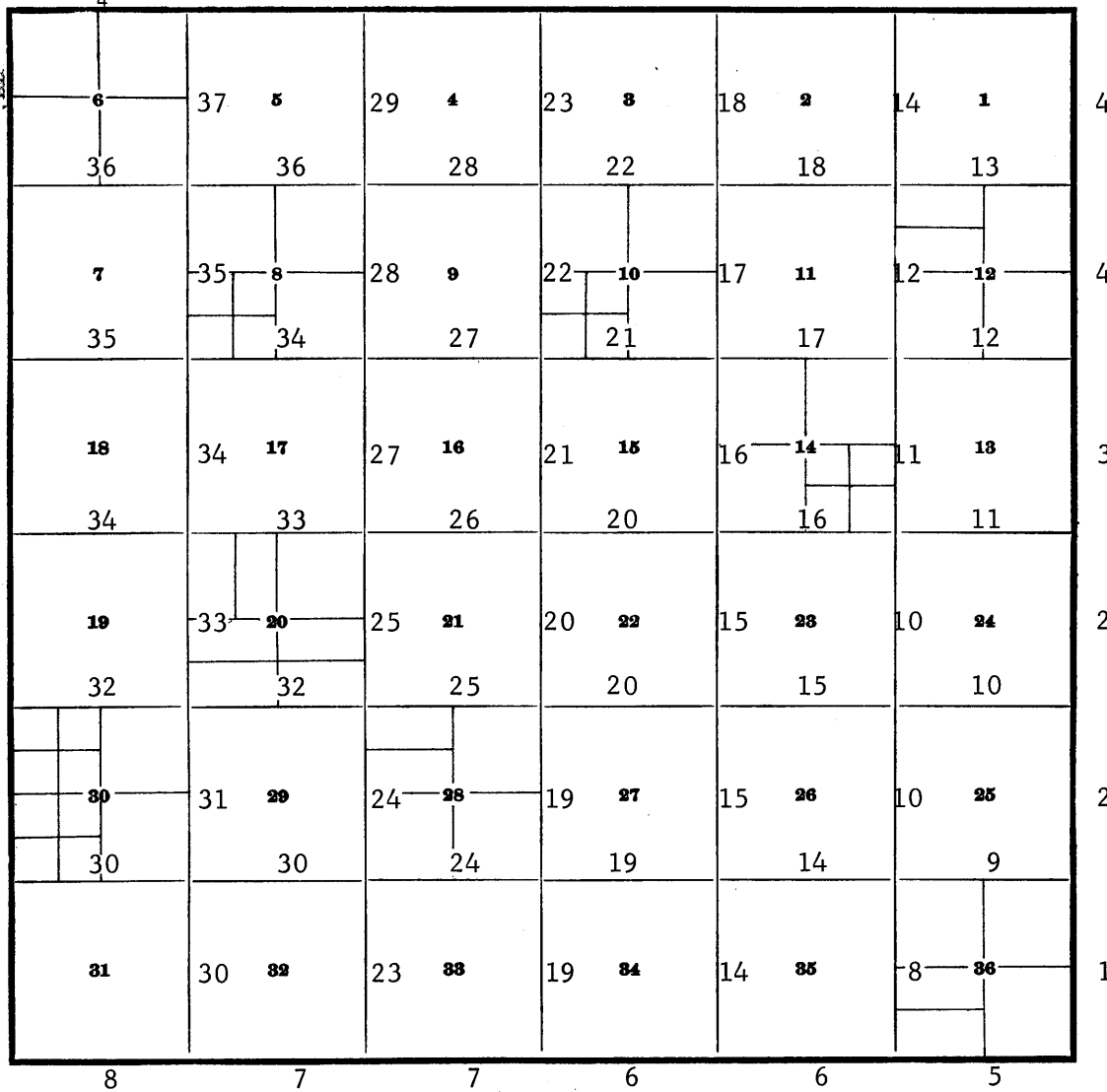

	<p>The south boundary of Township 20 North, Range 20 East was surveyed in 1882 by H. Meyrick. The south boundary was retraced under Group 449 in 1966 by Owens and Oviatt who remonumented the corner of Townships 19 and 20 North, Ranges 20 and 21 East. The east boundary was surveyed in 1882 by F. Follman. The north boundary, the Fifth Standard Parallel North, was surveyed in 1882 by F. Follman and resurveyed in 1947 by Ty White. The west boundary was surveyed in 1882 by F. Follman, retraced in 1966 by Owens and Oviatt, and resurveyed concurrently under this same group. The field note record thereof is included under Township 20 North, Range 19 East. The subdivisional lines were surveyed in 1882 by F. Follman.</p> <p>The following field notes are those of a dependent resurvey of the east and south boundaries and subdivisional lines, designed to restore the corners to their true original location according to the best available evidence, together with the establishment of the north <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> section corner of section 6, and the survey of subdivisions in sections 6, 8, 10, 12, 14, 20, 28, 30 and 36, Township 20 North, Range 19 East, Gila and Salt River Meridian, Arizona.</p> <p>This resurvey was executed in accordance with the specifications as set forth in the Manual of Surveying Instructions, 1947, and Special Instructions dated June 23, 1967.</p> <p>Only the true line bearings and horizontal distances for the surveyed lines are given in these field notes. Unless described, each corner was monumented with a standard iron post, 30 inches long, <math>2\frac{1}{2}</math> inches in diameter, flanged at the base and with a brass cap riveted to the top.</p> <p>The geographic position of the southeast corner of the township as determined by traverse from U.S.C. &amp; G.S. triangulation station "ASYLUM" is: Latitude <math>35^{\circ}04'58''</math> North, and Longitude <math>110^{\circ}09'50''</math> West.</p> <p>The mean magnetic declination was observed to be <math>14^{\circ}</math> E.</p> <hr/> <p style="text-align: center;">Dependent Resurvey of the East Boundary, T. 20 N., R. 20 E., G&amp;SRM, Arizona</p> <hr/> <p style="text-align: center;">Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by F.
