CHAINS

The boundaries and subdivisional lines were surveyed in 1882 by O. D. Wheeler. The south and west boundaries were resurveyed in 1917 by Matthews and Strickler. The north boundary (the Fifth Standard Parallel North) was resurveyed in 1947 by Ty White.

The following field notes are those of a dependent re-survey of the east boundary and a portion of the subdivisional lines, Township 20 North, Range 14 East, Gila and Salt River Meridian, Arizona, designed to restore the corners in their true original location according to the best available evidence.

This survey was executed in accordance with the specifications as set forth in the Manual of Surveying Instructions, 1947, and the Special Instructions dated June 21, 1968.

Only the true line bearings and horizontal distances for the surveyed lines are given in these notes. Unless described, each corner was monumented with a standard iron post 30 inches long, 2½ inches diameter, flanged at the base and with a brass cap riveted to the top.

The geographic position of the SE. corner of the township, as determined by traverse to USC&GS triangulation station Mesa Spur, is Latitude 35°04'59.3" N. and Longitude 110°48'04.2" W.

The mean magnetic declination was found to be 15° East.
