## CHAINS

The following field notes are these of the dependent resurvey of a portion of the Arizona-New Mexico State Line from the 203rd mile corner to the 206th mile cor. and from the 207th mile corner to the 208th mile cor., the dependent resurvey of portions of the south boundary, north boundary and subdivisional lines, and a survey of subdivisions in sections 2, 21, 22, and 27, Township 7 North, Range 31 East, Gila and Salt River Meridian, Arizona.

Chandler Robbins surveyed the east boundary (Arizona-New Mexico State Line), in 1875. C. Burton Foster surveyed a portion of the west boundary in 1875. W.R. Fitzgerald resurveyed the north three miles of the west boundary and surveyed the south three miles of the west boundary, the south and north boundaries and the subdivisional lines in 1883. W.H. Thorn resurveyed the east boundary (Arizona-New Mexico State Line), and a portion of the north boundary in 1902-03. Benjamin J. Kinsey resurveyed the west boundary in 1925. Lloyd E. Toland dependently resurveyed a portion of the state line in 1937 while surveying in Township 4 South, Range 21 West, New Mexico Principal Meridian. Roger F. Wilson reconstructed the northwest corner of section 2 in 1936 while surveying in Township 8 North, Range 31 East, Gila and Salt River Meridian. Gary T. Oviatt retraced a portion of the east boundary (Arizona-New Mexico State Line), and resurveyed a portion of the south boundary in 1969. The corner of sections 2, 3, 10, and 11 was remonumented by Charles C. Doak of the U.S. Forest Service in 1974. Paul L. Reeves remonumented the southwest corner of section 34 in 1976 while surveying in Township 6 North, Range 31 East. A portion of the east boundary (Arizona-New Mexico State Line), was retraced and a portion of the north boundary was resurveyed by Harry K. Smith in 1979.

The survey was executed in accordance with specifications set forth in the Manual of Surveying Instructions, 1973, and the Special Instructions for Group No. 646, Arizona dated August 5, 1983.

The direction of the lines of this survey was determined by altitude observations on the sun and refer to the true meridian. Distances were measured with a Hewlett Packard 3820A and Ziess Elta 46, total station instruments.

## CHAINS

Preliminary to the resurvey the lines of the surveys were retraced and search was made for all corners and other calls of the record. Identified corners were remonumented in their original positions; lost corners were restored and monumented at proportionate positions based on the original record. The retracement data were thoroughly verified and only the true line field notes are given herein.

The geographic position of the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34, and 35, Tps. 6 and 7 N, R 31 E, as computed from a tie to U.S.G.S. triangulation station "Loco", located in sec. 17, T 7 N, R 31 E, is as follows:
