This survey was executed with a W. and L. E. Gurley light mountain transit equipped with a Burt solar attachment. The distances were measured with a 400 lk. steel tape directly on the slope and the slope angles determined with a clinometer.

August 28, 1913. I test Burt solar attachment on meridian established at cor. 11 H. E. S. No. 89 by observation on Polaris at E. elong. and find same to be in adjustment. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by solar observation.

August 29, 1913. 9h. Om. a.m., l.m.t., I set off $09^{\circ} 26-1/2'$ on decl. arc and $34^{\circ} 29-1/2'$ on lat. arc and determine the meridian at cor. No. 1. I check this meridian by subsequent observation in the afternoon.

No mineralization is in evidence on the claim and it is apparently nonmineral in character.
