. Survey commenced August 21, 1913, and executed with a W. and L. E. Gurley light mountain transit equipped with a. Burt solar attachment.

The distances were measured with a 200 and 400 lk. steel rises tape directly on the slope and the slope angles determined by a clinometer.

> The courses of this survey were deflected from the true meridian as established at cor. No. 1 by obsn. on Polaris at E. elong. Lat. at cor. No., 1, 34° 13' N., which was determined by direct obsn. with Burt solar. Long. 111° 54' W., derived from instructions of the Surveyor General.

August 21, 1913; I set transit at cor. No. 1, set off the Azimuth of Polaris 1° 24' to the west of the line of sight of last night's observation, thus establishing the true meridian. This meridian was checked by two subsequent observations with the Burt solar attachment.


