DESCRIPTION.

This claim covers the valley formed by Ash Creek and is practically level, having a very gentle slope to the SE., and is traversed by Ash Creek.

The soil is deep and fertile and well adapted to agricultural purposes.

There is no timber of commercial value on the claim. Water for domestic and stock purposes is obtained from the well near the house. Water for irrigation purposes is obtained from Ash Creek, the head of the ditch being about 1/2 mile above the NW. end of the claim.
