the flaim lies along the bottom of McClarys Canyon, at the foot of the west side of the Santa Rita Mountains.

There is approximately twenty acres of the area suitable for agricultural purposes. The soil is a weathering product of granite and silt brought down from the mountains. The whole area is covered with a heavy growth of mesquit and catclaw. The claimant had cultivated a considerable area of List 3-482 lying within the Santa Rita Range Reserve.

Water for domestic use and for watering cattle is obtained from wells on the claim. There is no water for irrigation. The claim is primarily of value for a stock ranch headquarters for which it is being used.

There is no timber of commercial value on the claim.

There is no indication of mineral on the claim, though there are several old abandoned prospects in the vicinity.

CONFLICTS AND ADJOINING CLAIMS

There are no conflicts. The claim is joined on the west by the Santa Rita Range Reserve.

2. In balancing Latitudes and Departures do not obliterate or change the original figures.

Put the corrected figure or figures above in red ink. Do not change the footing of the original figures, but put below them the corrected flow or figures above in red ink. Do not change the footing of the lines.

The corrections for balancing fallings should be proportional to the lengths of the lines.

3. In calculations of fallings take result to nearest link. In calculations of N. and S. areas drop all after second decimal. Surveyors are required to use the Standard Field Tables issued by the G. L. O. 4. Only three copies of this tabulation are necessary, for the District Office, the Surveyor General, and the Commissioner.
