The location as given in this survey is determined by bearings to natural objects and fairly well located points on Arizona Power Co. project as these appear on Prescott Base Map. U.S.L.M.No. 44 H E S was in plain view, from U.S.L.M.No. 320 H E S and the location as given in original notes of the first named monument is evidently in error.
