DESCRIPTION

This claim lies on Ash Creek at an elevation of 4700 ft., and consists of bottom land along the creek, rough rocky hillsides on SW. and low brushy ridges on NW. general slope is to the SE.

The soil in the bottom is a sandy loam of good depth and produces good crops. On the slopes, the soil is shallow, rocky and non-agricultural.

Water for irrigation and domestic use is obtained from Ash Creek.

There is no timber of commercial value on the claim. The hillsides are covered with oak brush, and along the creek are sycamore, walnut, cottonwood and hackberry.

I saw no indications of mineral upon the claim, although it lies in a mineralized section.

There are approximately 3-1/2 acres in cultivation on the metes and bounds portion of the entry.

Directions.—1. Carry out calculations to two decimals only.

2. In balancing Latitudes and Departures do not obliterate or change the original figures.
