# DESCRIPTION , ,

The claim consists mainly of open bottom land at the junction of several small shallow draws. The general slope is to the North.

The soil is a black sandy loam of good depth and very fertile. Dry farming methods must be resorted to in order to grow crops. There is no water on the claim and the prospects of developing water are very meager. Water for domestic use is hauled from Heber, about 2-1/2 miles distant.

Approximately 90 percent of the area is suitable for agricultural purposes, of which 80 acres were under cultivation at the time of survey.

There is no timber of commercial value on the claim.
