The claim lies at the junction of Hannigan and Beaver

creeks. About 80% of the area is suitable for agri
cultural purposes. The soil is a dark loam of good

depth and very fertile. The rainfall is depended upon

to grow crops. Water for domestic use is obtained

from Hannigan Creek which traverses the SE. portion of

the claim.

There is no timber of commercial value on the claim.

I saw no indication of mineral on the claim.

CONFLICTS AND ADJOINING CLAIMS

There are no conflicts. The claim is adjoined on the NW. by HES 505. HES No. 597, surveyed by me on June 12 13, 1921, lies about 3/4 mile to SE. HES 595, surveyed by me on June 14, 1921, lies about 1 mile to East. HES 593, surveyed by me on June/7, 1921, lies about 1-1/2 miles to NW.

Espero, Arizona, postoffice, lies about 2 miles to NW. Alpine, Arizona, the nearest settlement and trading point, lies about 17 miles to NE. and is reached by trail.

Springerville, Arizona, the general trading point for this section of the country, lies about 38 miles dist. in a northerly direction and is reached by fair wagon road.
