The tunnel starts about 50 feet from discovery-shaft and runs due east, then bears and takes a north-easterly course, is 76 feet in length, 4 feet 8 inches in width and 5 feet 8 inches in height - not timbered.

In my opinion more than 500 Dollars worth of Labor has been expended on this mine.

The "Oriental-Lode" is situated about $\frac{3}{4}$ mile from the discovery shaft on the "Pecklode" and about 250 feet East of War-Eagle-gulch and some distance from Trail running from Prescott to Peckmine; said Trail following War-Eagle-gulch from Peck-Mine to junction with Bear Creek.

It is in a slate formation in rolling country covered with hills, some rising into prominent peaks. A few oaks - and Juniper trees in vicinity; some Pines in War-Eagle-gulch, sides of hills covered with dense undergrowth; Water in War-Eagle-gulch, about 300 feet from discovery shaft.

Said Claim is situated in Peck-Mining-District, County of Yavapai, Territory of Arizona. Public Land-Surveys not extended to vicinity of Claim. -


