The Strike of the vein is N  $70^{\circ}$  W and S  $70^{\circ}$  E and dip about  $80^{\circ}$  S of E

The improvements are as follows viz:

The main shaft sunk on the vein at the initial movement to a depth of 120 ft with drifts running each way on the vein 20 ft from a point 10 ft above the bottom of shaft. Tunnel No 1 75 ft in length running on the vein and cutting the main shaft at a point 40 ft below the surface and 20 ft from the mouth of the tunnel
