The McClellan Mining Claim is situated, about one, and one quarter miles easterly from the village of Charleston; about eight miles southwesterly from the city of Tombstone; about three fourths of one mile southerly from Williams Spring, and is the second extension northeasterly of the "Dean Richmond Mining Claim", all in Tombstone District; Cochise County, Arizona.

Its surface is uneven, being upon a rolling mesa which is covered with greasewood.

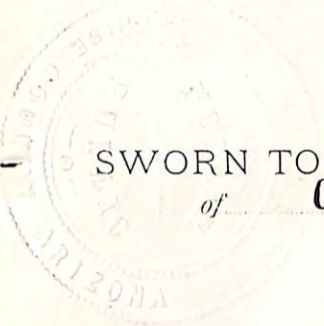

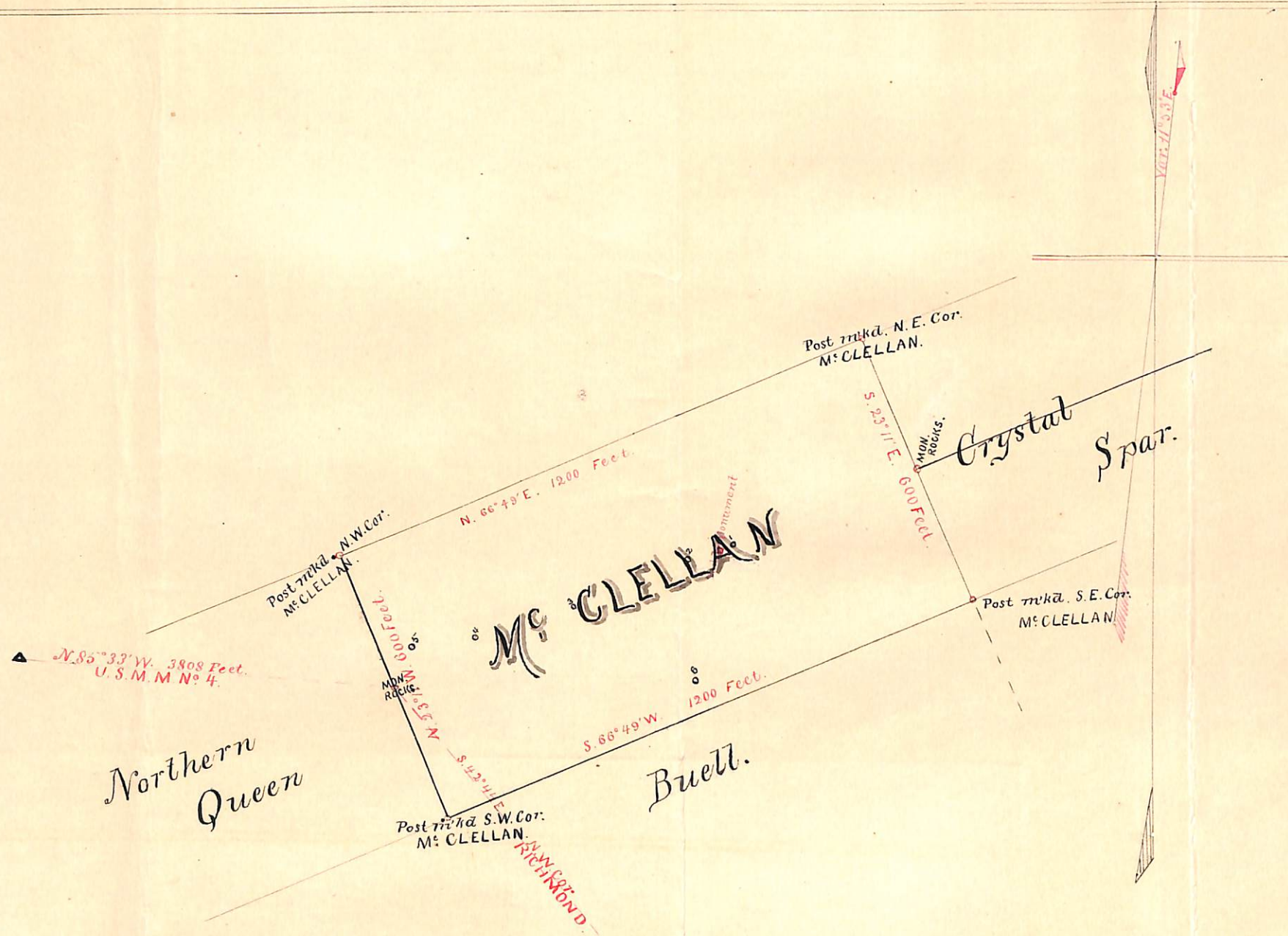
