General Description.

The McClellan Mining claim is situate, about one, and one quarter miles easterly from the village of Leharleson, about eight miles southwesterly from the city of Tombstone; about three fourths of one mile southerly from Williams Spring, <sup>and</sup> is the second extension northeasterly of the "Dean Richmond Mining claim," all in Tombstone District, Cochise County, Arizona.

Its surface is uneven, being upon a rolling mesa, which is covered with greasewood.

The improvements made by the claimants consist of six shafts,




