Field Notes of the Blue Bird
Mining Claim Surveyed Sept. 2^d 1881

By virtue of an order from the Surveyor General John Mason bearing date Aug. 27th 1881 I have this day made an official survey of the Blue Bird Mining Claim situated in Globe Mining District Gila County A.T.

Beginning at the Initial Point near the top of the Blue Bird hill, the point being marked by a monument of stones 2 1/2 feet high on the outcrop marked B.B.I.P. with a chisel from whence Apache Peak bears N. 40° 00' E. The left hand one of the Four Peaks bears N. 65° 45' W. Stone Pillow on the left of Ragged Mountain S. 52° 00' W.

Thence N. 77° 56' E. 656.7 feet crossing one ravine to a monument of stones 3 feet high (not marked) situated on a back bone, being the N.E. End of this claim and the S.W. End of the Emeline

Thence N. 3° 37' W. 300 feet to a monument situated on the east slope of the hill near the bottom, said monument consists of a post 4x6 inches 4 feet long 1 foot in the ground surrounded by a mound of stones 2 feet high marked on the east side of the post E.N.W.C. and on the West side B.B. 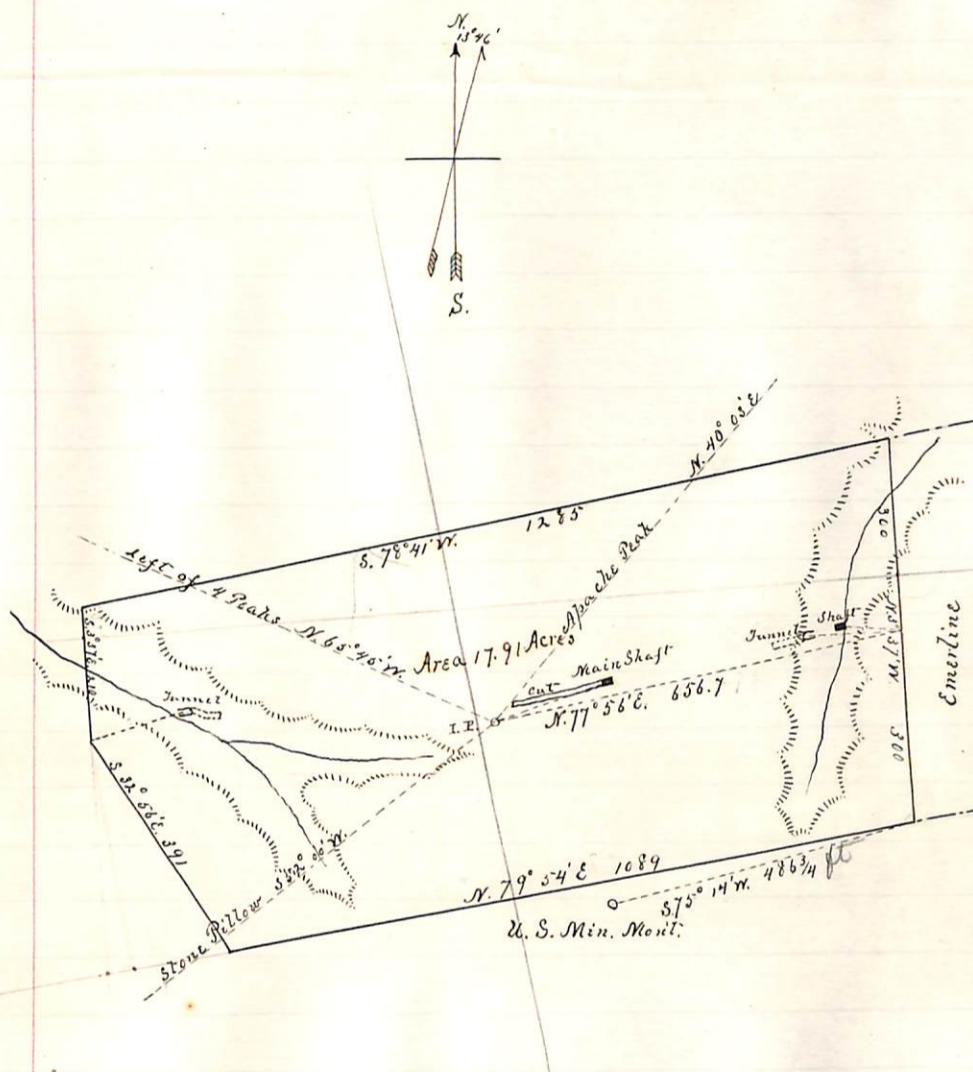
