The mouth of the Tunnel is about 5×7 ft. but at a distance of 30. ft. in, a large chamber has been excavated, $10 \times 10 \times 10$ feet. From this point, a cross cut was run 4×6 ft. westerly a distance of 24 feet.

Also from this chamber a shaft has been sunk upon the ledge, a distance of 38 feet; the same being upon an incline. The Tunnel continues from this point to the northward, 53 feet, making its total length 83 feet.

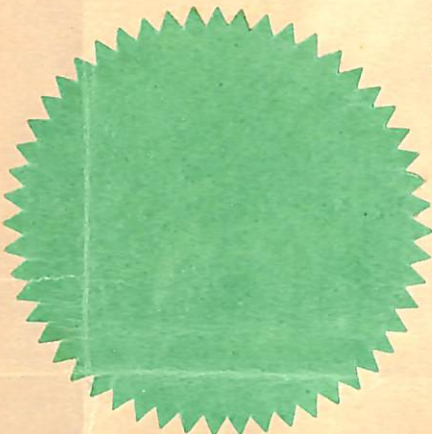

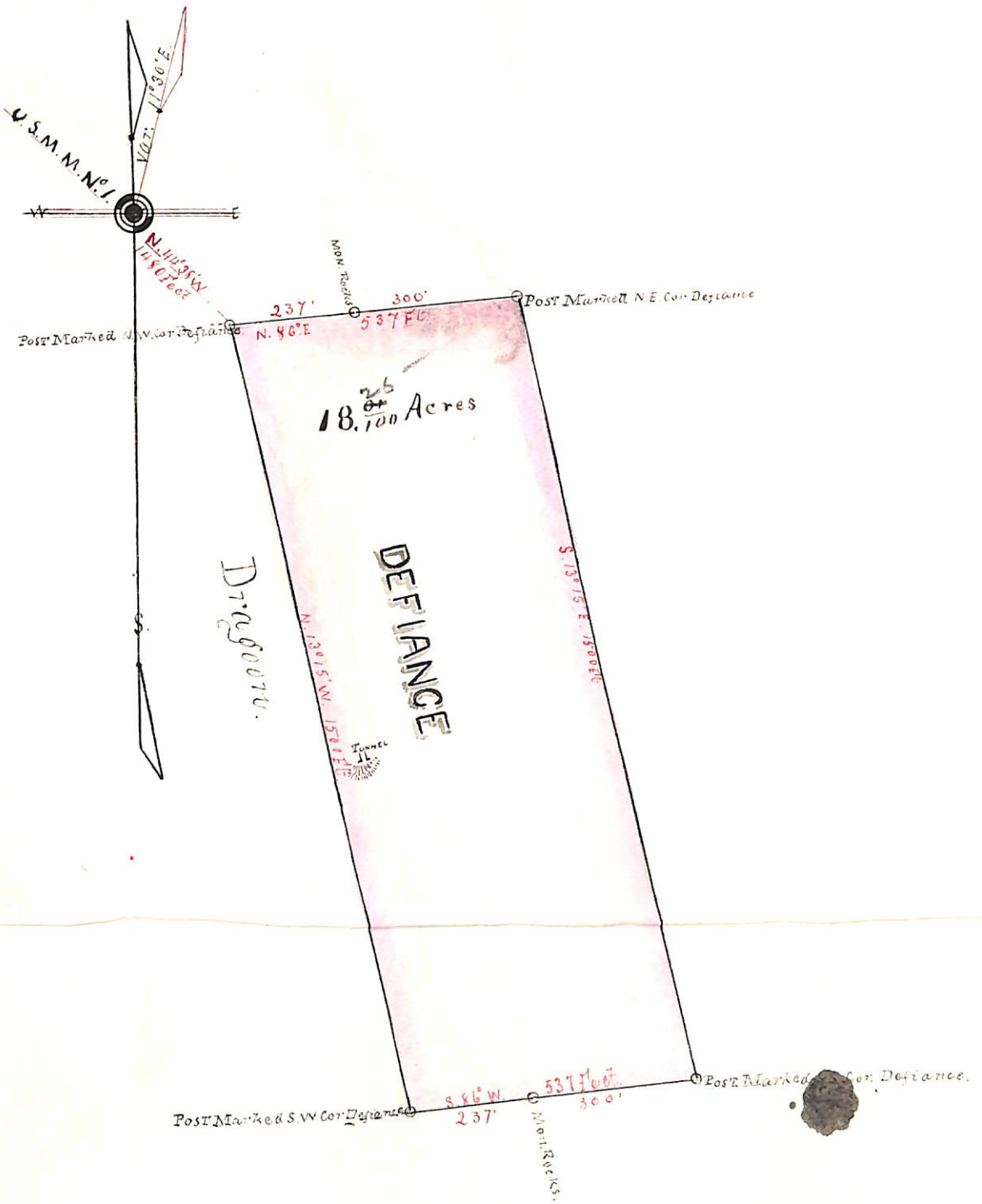
