

Upon the application of Alpheus Lewis et al. to survey and define the boundaries of the "Oxay" mining claim situate in Tombstone Mining District County of Cochise Territory of Arizona and having received an order for the survey of said claim from Hon John Hason Surveyor General for the Territory of Arizona dated October 7<sup>th</sup> A.D. 1881 (but evidently intended for November 7<sup>th</sup> A.D. 1881.) and also at the same time received a duly authenticated copy of the original and amended or supplemental notices of location of said claim (which said papers are hereto attached and herewith transmitted) and having tested my chain and found it to conform to the requirements of the law and having my transit in perfect adjustment & compared it with the True Meridian established January 18<sup>th</sup> 1881 and found the variation to be 11° 53' E. I then proceeded to the Northeast corner of claim; and from thence surveyed and measured said mining claim, I commenced said survey and completed it on the 7<sup>th</sup> of November A.D. 1881, as set forth in the following.


