Field Notes of Survey of Tombstone Mining Claim

Tombstone Mining District.
Cochise County. Arizona Ter'y.

Survey commenced February 21st /82
Survey completed Feb 28th 1882.

By comparison with the Standard Meridian established for Tombstone mining District, I find the variation of my Transit to be $11^{\circ} 25'$ East.

I commence at the initial monument as described in the Notice of location, where I find a post of 4 ins sqs in monument of stone, marked T.M. Tombstone N.C. No 1. monument built upon croppings of ledge, which are very wide at this point, placing a flag at the south west center end of claim, which is also the initial monument of the Carbonate mining Claims Lot. No 45.

As this point is the nearest point to the South boundary of Township 20. S. Range 21. E.

I run South $18^{\circ} 32' W$ 11058. feet to standard cor to secs 32nd & 33rd, a lime stone $12 \times 8 \times 6$ ins marked S.C. with 4 notches on E and 3 notches on W edges, with 3 pits N.E. and W.

being now at the center of the Easterly end line of the Carbonate mining Claims and having a copy of the official Field Notes of this line. I carefully adjust my Transit and find the bearing of this end line of the Carbonate mining Claims ^{Lot no. 45} to be $N 18^{\circ} 02' W$ and $S 18^{\circ} 02' E$. The official notes give the same line of $N 17^{\circ} 42' W$ and $S 17^{\circ} 42' E$, which shows a difference

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

