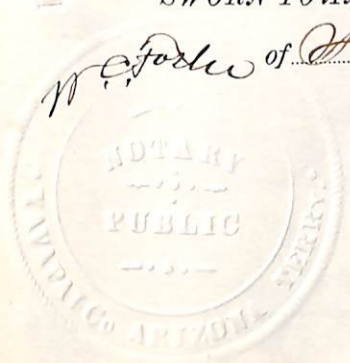

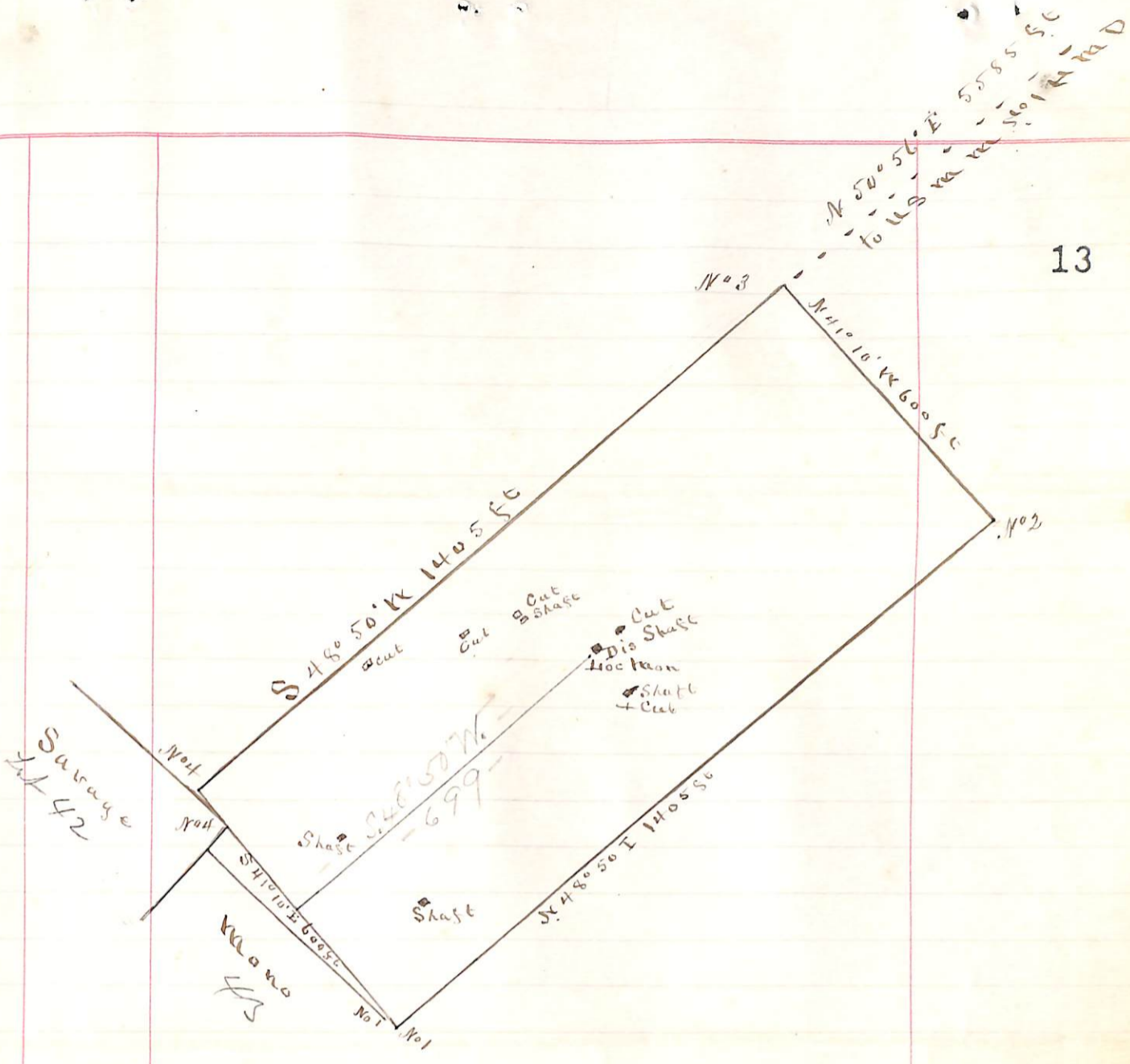




Plat
