Notice of Location.— Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of an Act of Congress dated May 10. 1872, I the undersigned have this day located and claimed Fifteen Hundred (1500) linear feet on this vein or lode of silver or other mineral bearing ore and Three Hundred (300) feet in width on each side thereof situated and described as follows, to wit:


