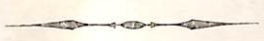

The "Bilk" mining claim is located 5 miles
in a north easterly direction from the City
of Pinal near the Foot of Stonemans Grade
bounded on the East by the "Silver King",
on the south by the "Kansas Sufferer",
on the north by the "Essex" and on the
west by the "Mowry" Mining claims, in
Pioneer Mining District Pinal County
Arizona Territory at an altitude of about
3950 ft. above the level of the sea. The
claim is located on the southerly
slope of the hill, its surface is entirely
barren of timber and embraces nearly
the north half of the village of
Silver King. The workings and im-
provements made by the applicants
and the grantors are as follows.
