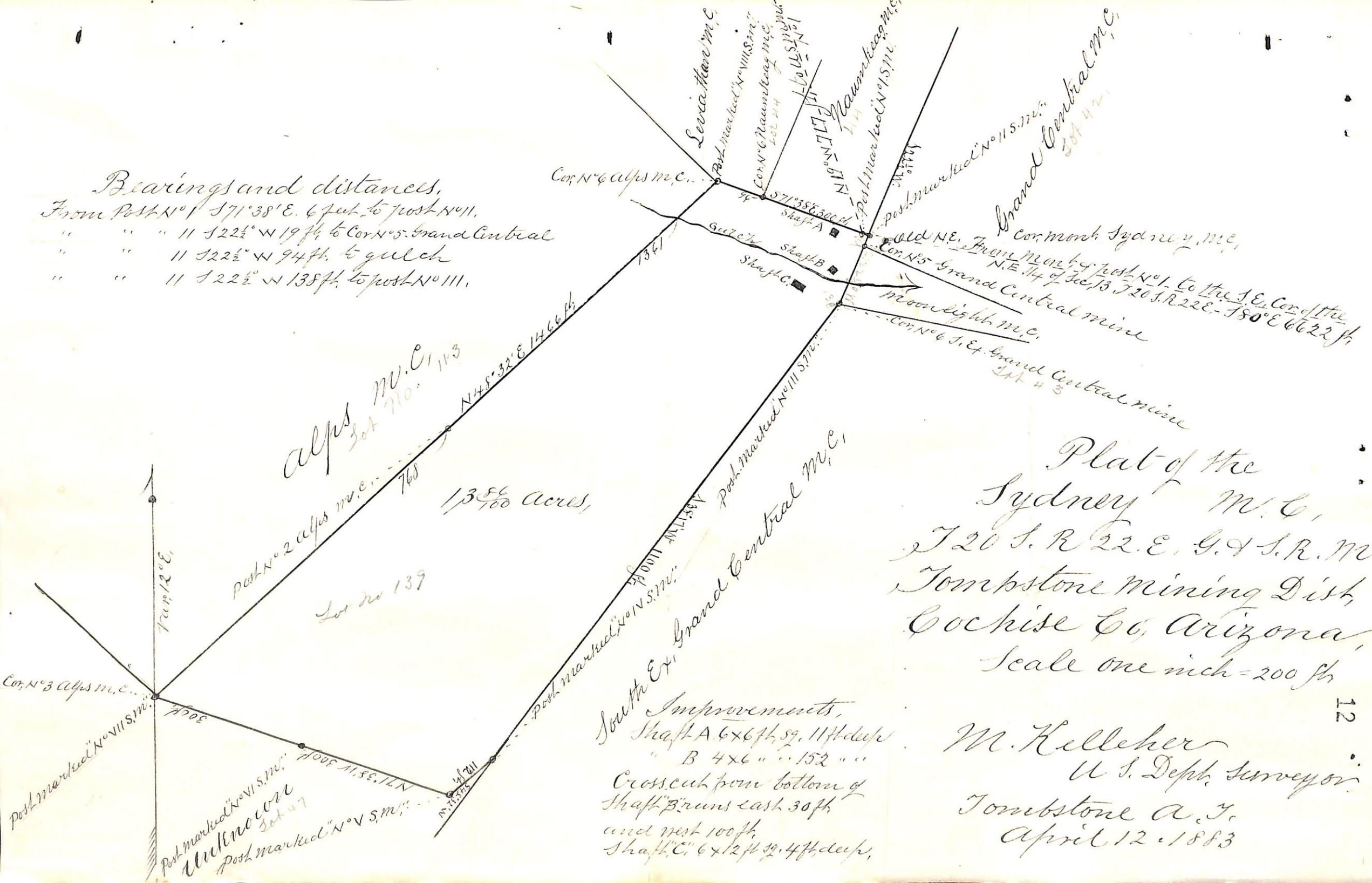

 Scale one inch = 200 ft


