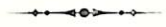

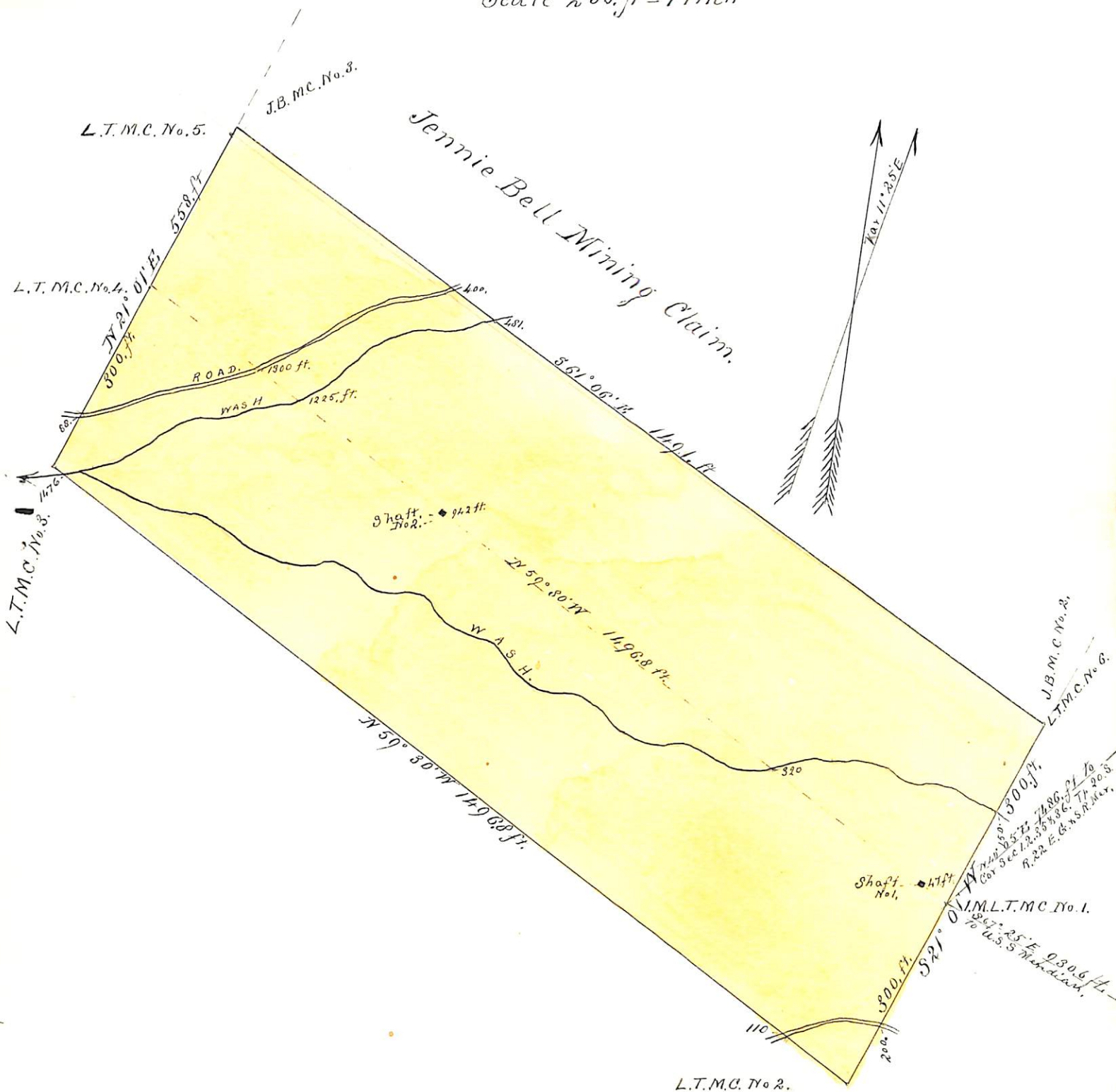
Little Tom Mining Claim.
