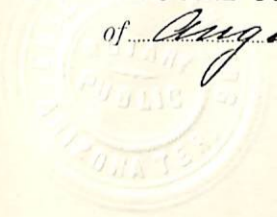

Notice of Location

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned, in compliance with the requirements of the Mining Act of Congress, approved May 10th 1872, have this day located and claim, fifteen hundred linear feet along the course of this lead lode or vein of mineral-bearing quartz and three hundred feet in width on each side of the middle of said lead lode or vein, situated in Mineral Point foothills of the Black Hills range of Mountains, Yavapai County Arizona and more particularly defined as follows, to wit:

Commencing at a monument of Stones in which a duplicate copy of this notice is pasted, on the south westerly end of the claim at the center thereof; thence South easterly 300 feet to a monument of Stones; thence North easterly 1500 feet to a monument of Stones; thence North westerly 300 feet to a monument of Stones being in the center of the North easterly end of claim; thence North easterly 300 feet to a monument of Stones; thence South westerly 1500 feet to a monument of Stones; thence South easterly 300 feet to the place of beginning. This claim was

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first located by J. H. Emmet and
Chas. McKinney on the 17th day of December
1875 in two separate locations on the
vein. It was subsequently acquired
by purchase by the undersigned who
are now the sole owners thereof. The
~~two~~ two claims are consolidated in
this notice by leaving off a part
of each. The original "Notices of
Location" were so defective that
a survey of the claims was refused
by the Surveyor General on account
thereof. This relocation is made
to overcome these defects and also
to consolidate in one the two
claims. The mine is located at
the north west angle and at the foot
of "Emmet Butte" - one of the foot hills
of the Black Hills in Yavapai County
Arizona, $4\frac{1}{4}$ miles south easterly
from Coyote Springs and about
 $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles almost due south of the
mouth of Yerger Cañon. And shall
be known as the Emmet mine
January 8th 1883.

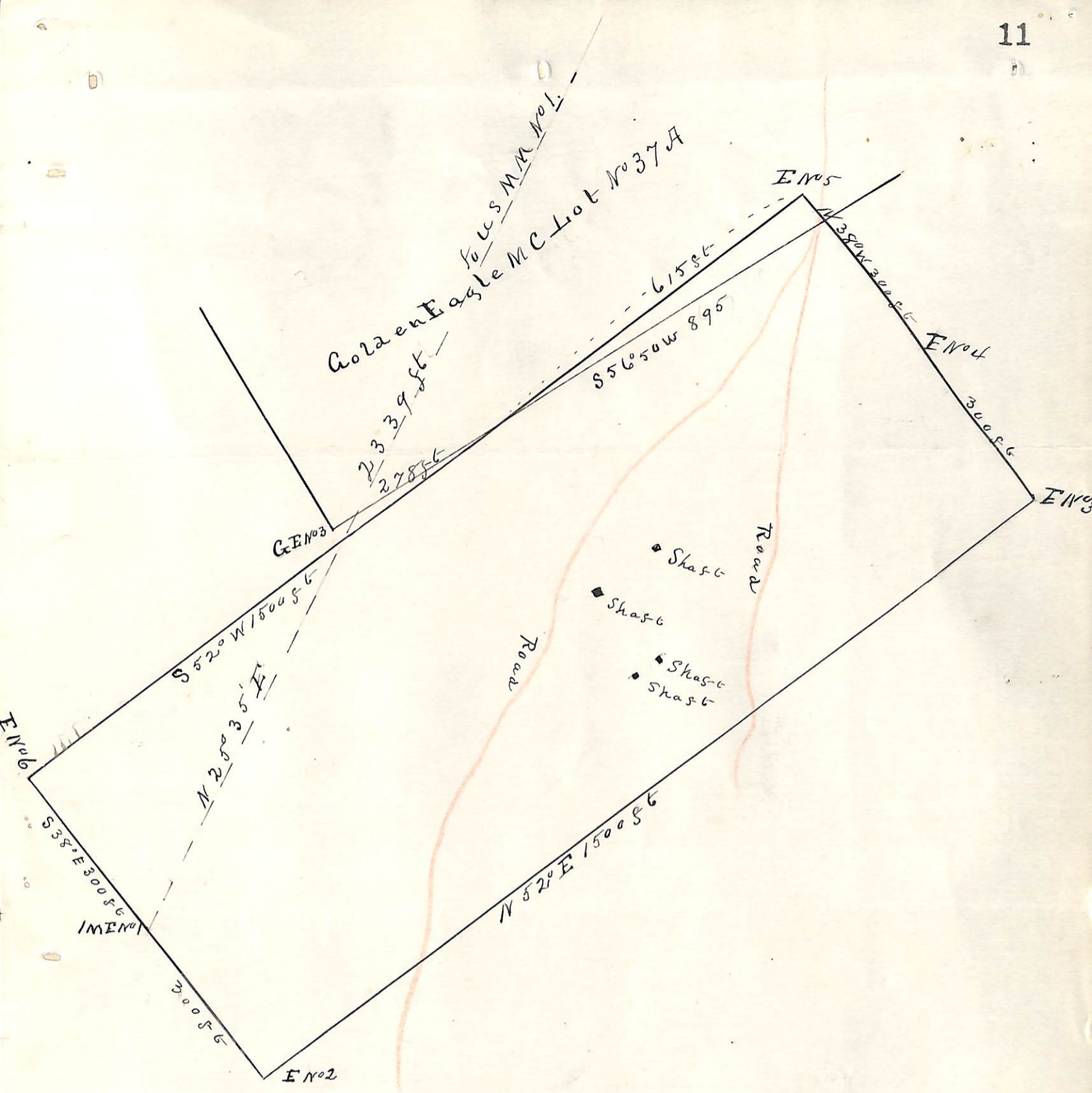
