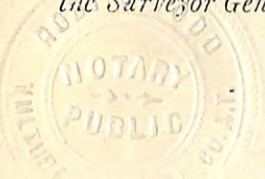

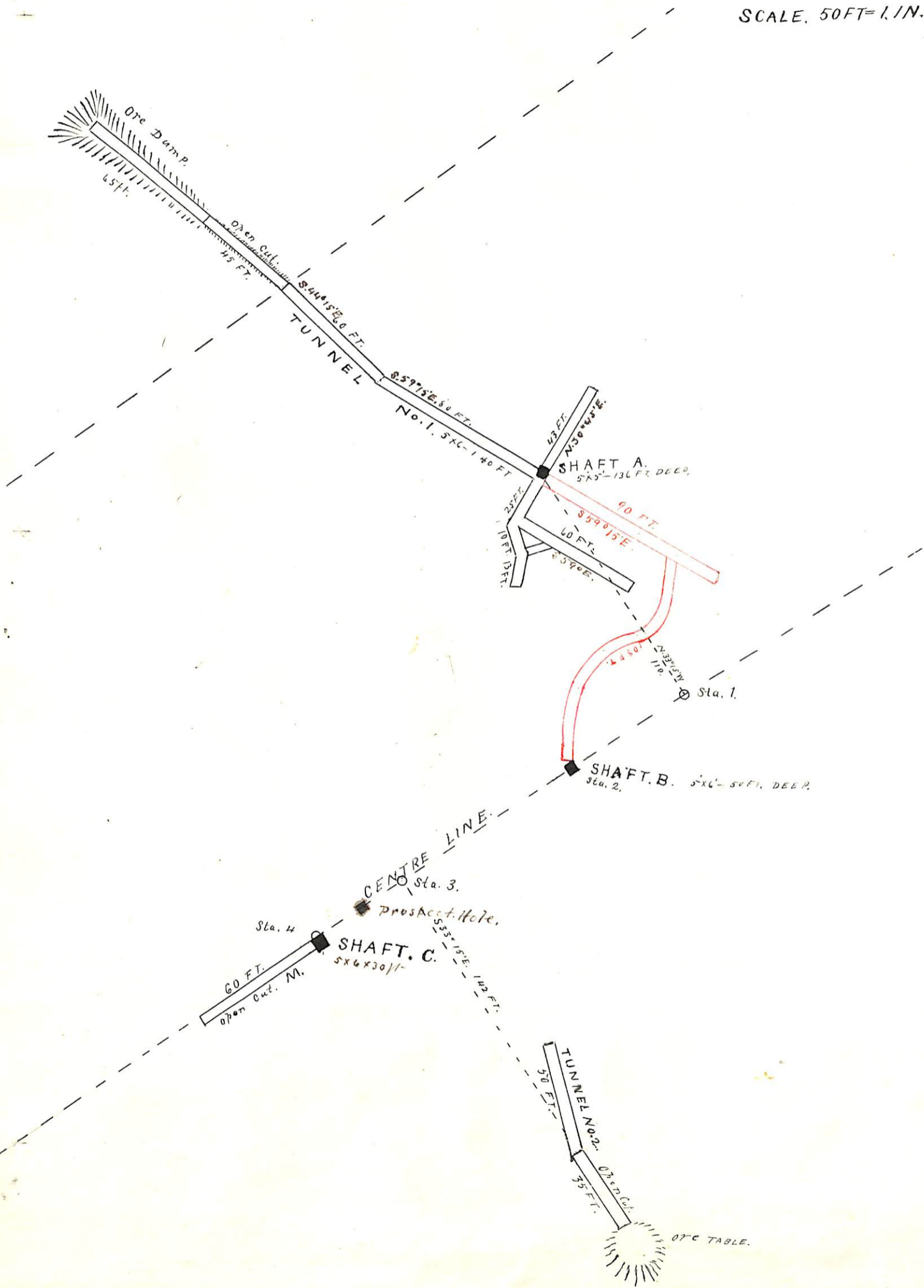

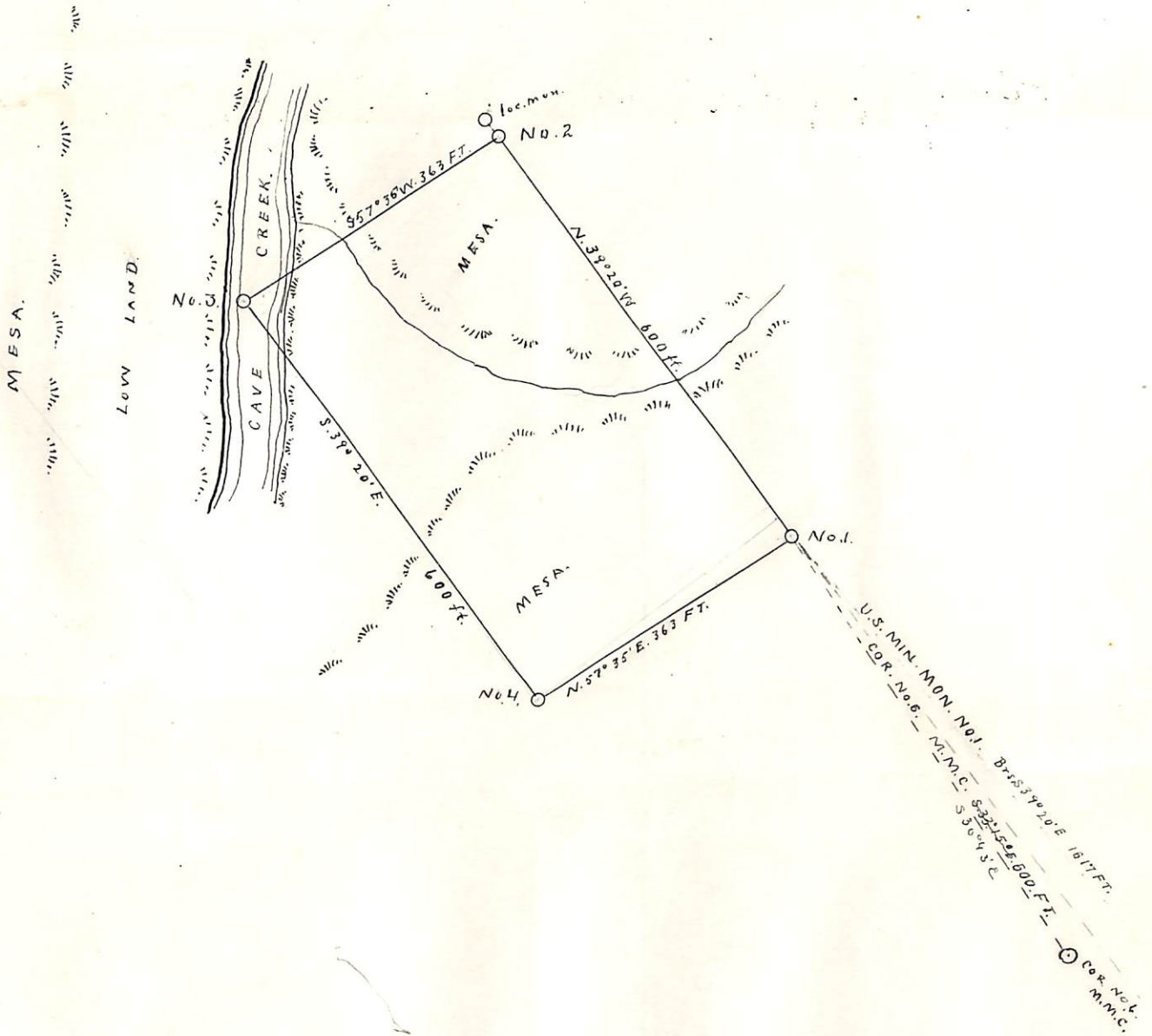

 CAVE CREEK DIST.

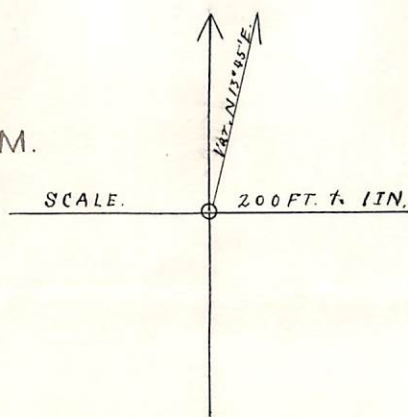

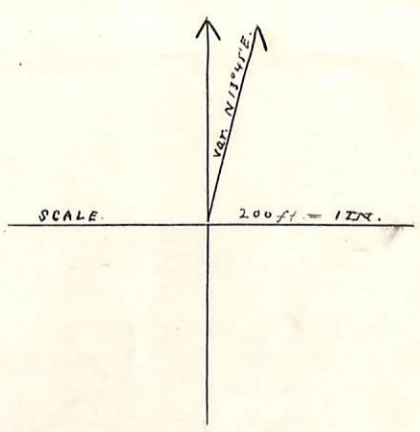
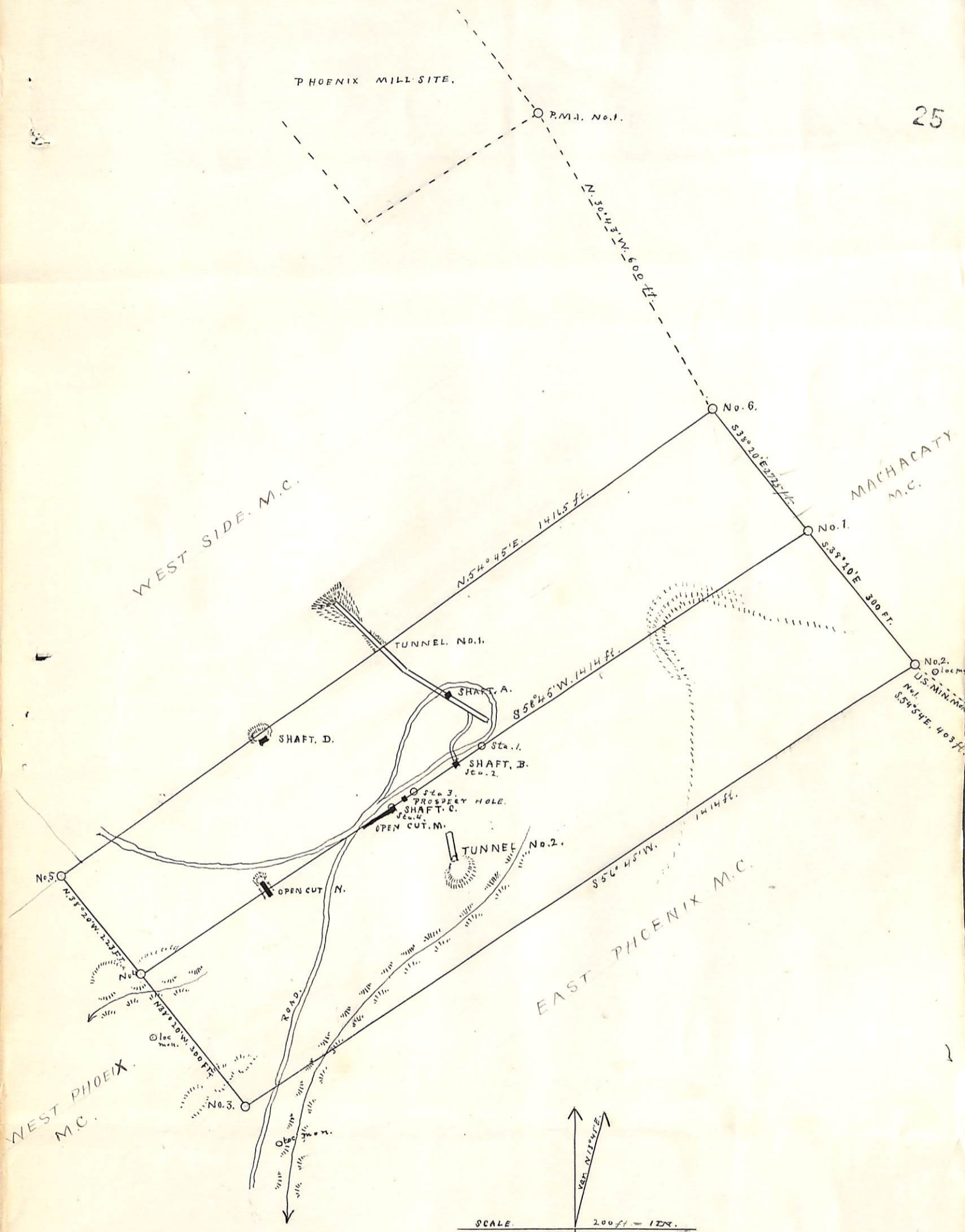
