"Sonoma Mine" Notice of Location. Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of an act of Congress dated Aug 10 1872 the undersigned have this day located and claimed, One vein of fifteen hundred linear feet on this vein or lode of Mineral bearing ore and three hundred feet in width on each side thereof. Situated and described as follows - to wit

Commencing at a monument of Stone on the ledge on the South end of Claim which bears South East from the old town of Oro Blanco and about one mile distant from said town. Thence running Easterly three hundred feet to monument of rock: Thence westerly parallel with ^{vein} fifteen hundred feet to monument of rock. Thence westerly crossing the vein six hundred feet to monument of rocks. Thence Southerly fifteen hundred feet to monument of rocks. Thence at right angles easterly to place of beginning. The South Center Monument is on a high peak and the Claim is about one quarter of a mile Easterly from a large Creek bed: This Claim shall be known as the "Sonoma Mine Oro Blanco district Pima County Arizona Territory, Oct 20 1877. 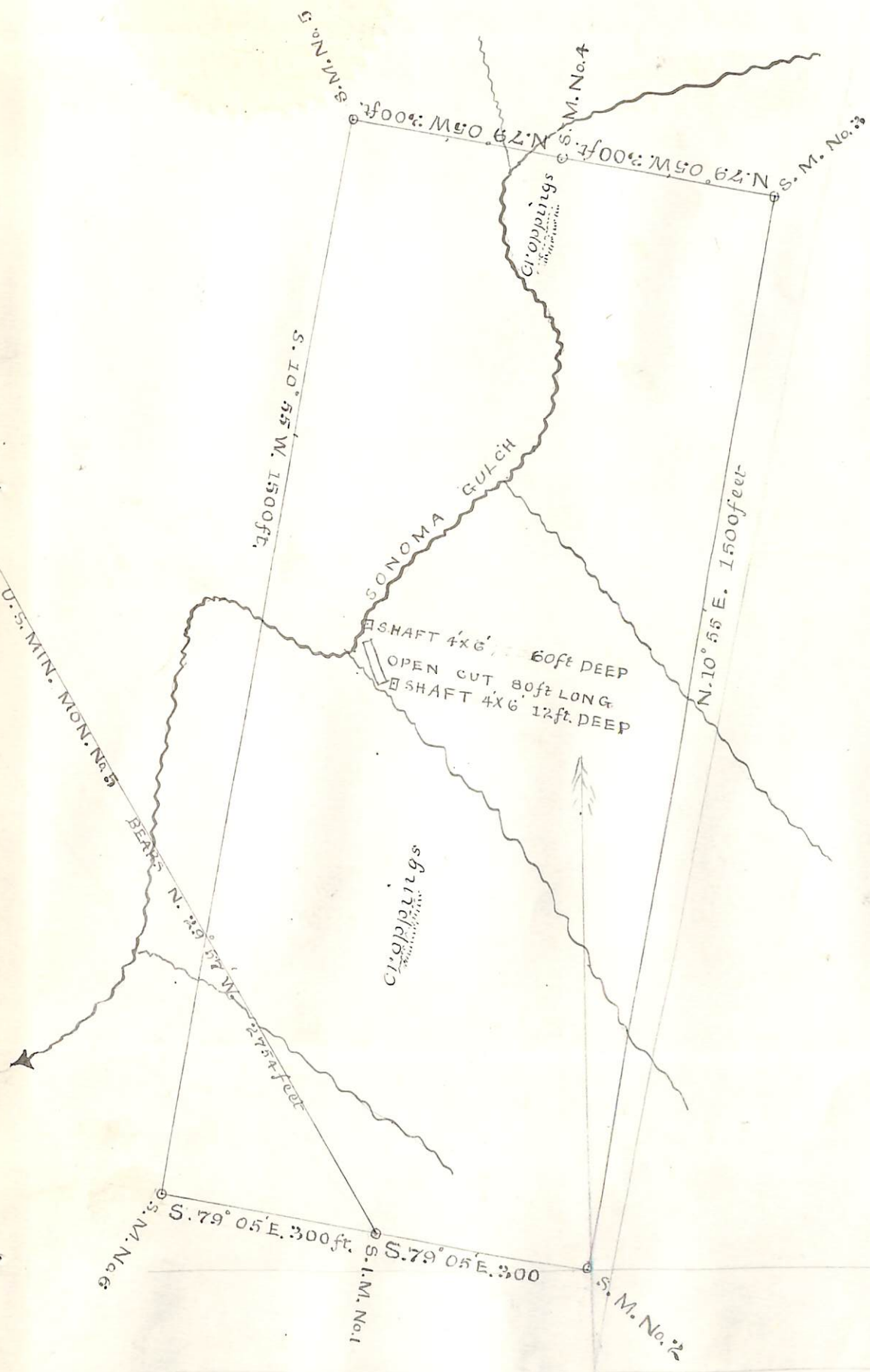
