A copy of which location was recorded in Book 5, page 798 of Transcribed Records of Mines to which reference is hereby made for greater certainty.

Being desirous of obtaining a patent for said mine and as a preliminary step thereto, wishing to have an Official Survey made thereof by a U. S. 
