Know all Men by these Presents:

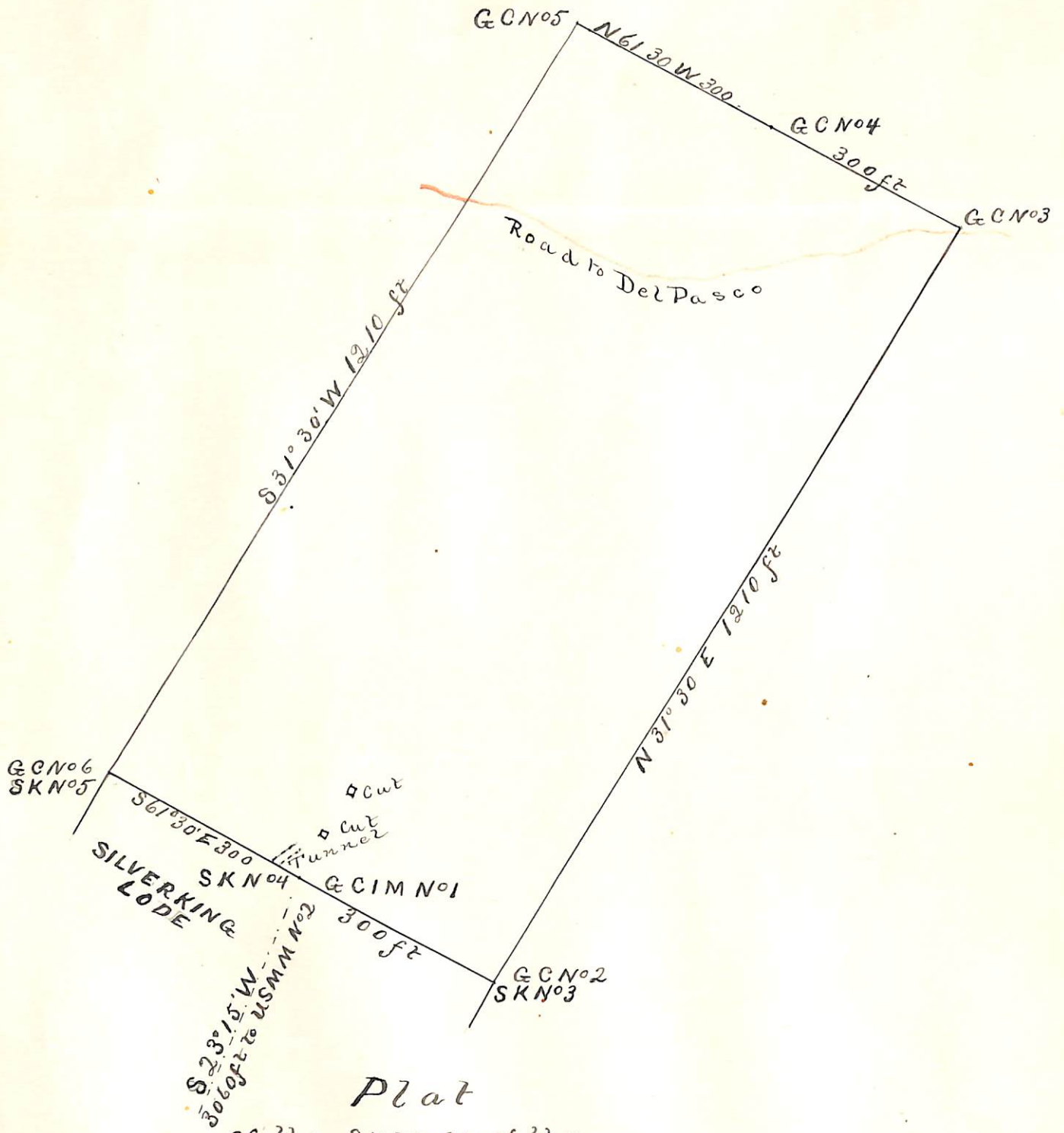
