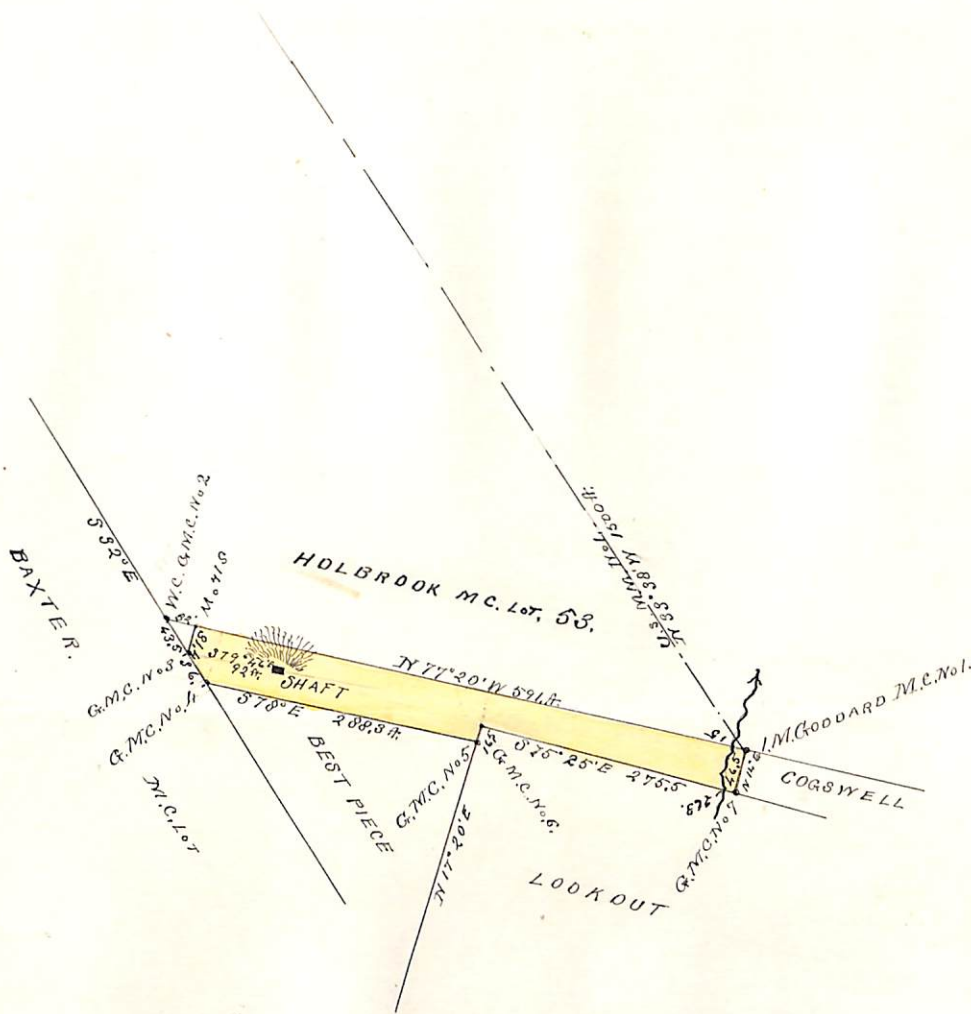

COCHISE COUNTY ARIZONA.


