CUMBERLAND MINING CLAIM


WARREN MINING DISTRICT

MEMORANDUM

Subject: Mineral Survey Patent No. 21787

In the process of reviewing mineral surveys for possible cancellation, an apparent error has been identified in BLM records.

The HI for Township 10 North, Range 6 West, Gila & Salt River Meridian, indicates that the Cumberland mining claim (listed as Lot 66) located in section 14 is patented under Patent No. 21787, dated August 3, 1892. Our survey plat indicates that the Cumberland mining claim located in section 14 is the survey of Lot 37, surveyed under General Survey No. 174. This survey record does not correspond in configuration, acreage, Lot No. or mining district to the patent description.

The Cumberland mining claim referenced in Patent No. 21787 is actually located in section 15, Township 23 South, Range 24 East, Gila & Salt River Meridian. It is the survey of Lot 66, comprising 10.57 acres, surveyed as Mineral Survey No. 862. The corresponding HI entry for this township is incomplete, showing the Lot 66 designation and correct patent date, but with no patent number or survey acreage.

With your concurrence, we are requesting that the HIs for these townships and other corresponding card files and/or records be corrected to reflect the appropriate application of Patent No. 21787. We will then correct our own Cadastral records and issue a cancellation memorandum for the unpatented survey, General Survey No. 174.
