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This discrepancy being so great I go to Post M. M. C. Tro 6. and take the bearing of the Easterty side line of the Mercimac M.C. which is Common to the west side line of the Clipper M.C. Lot No 105. And I find this line to bear 531° 20 W. and the official Notes of the clipper west side line, is 531. 17 W. while the official Notes of the Merrimac gives this same line at 57° 45'W. Jalso go to Post XXX No.2. which is also the S.E cor. Merrimac, and test the Southerby end line of the Mercimac which is also the Wortherby end line of the Triple Ex and find that line to bear Tr 5'8' sq' W, and the Easterly Side line of the Triple Ex. to bear 1548'18'W.
