


That Jno. S. Jones of the County of Yavapai, in the Territory of Arizona, claims by right of discovery and location, (1500) Fifteen Hundred feet linear and horizontal measurement on the Mizpah Lode, along the vein thereof, with all its dips, variations and angles; together with Three Hundred feet in width on each side of the middle of said vein at the surface; and all veins, lodes, ledges, deposits and unmined ground within the lines of said claim; Six Hundred feet on said lode running north-easterly from the center of the discovery shaft, and 900 feet running south-westerly from said center of discovery shaft.


