

SECTION 10. Such affidavit when so recorded shall be prima facie evidence of the performance of such labor or the making of such improve ments, and said original affidavit after it has been recorded, or a certified copy of record of same, shall be received as evidence accordingly by all the Courts of this Territory.

SECTION 11. The relocation of forfeited or abandoned lode claims shall only be made by sinking a new discovery shaft and fixing new boundaries in the same manner and to same extent as is required in making a new location; or the relocator may sink the original discovery shalf ten feet deeper than it was at date of commencement of such relocation, and shall erect new or make the old monuments the same as originally required.
