LOCATION.

This claim is located in Dos Cabezas Hining District Cochise county, Arizona, in Twp. 14 S. R. 27 E(unsurveyed) about four miles North of town of Dos Cabezas. U.S. Location Monument No. 1542 is within the boundaries of the Emersley claim.

On the Emersley, the lode extends from the \mathcal{S} . center end N. 39° 45' W. about 600 ft.


