In Act to Codify and Revise the Laws of the Territory of Arizona

SECTIONS 1-11 -INC. LOCATION OF CLAIMS

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Arizona:

Section 1. On the discovery of mineral in places on the public domain of the United States, the same may be located as a mineral claim by the discoverer for himself, for himself and others, or for others.

Section 2. Such location shall be made by erecting at or contiguous to the point of discovery, a conspicuous monument of stones not less than three (3) feet in height, or an upright post securely fixed, projecting at least four (4) feet above the ground, in which monument of stones or on which post, there shall be posted a location notice, which shall be signed by the name or names of the locators. The location notice must contain: First, the name of the claim located; second, the name or names of the locator; the date of the location; found, the length and width of the claim in feet and the distance in feet from the point of discovery to each end of the claim; fifth, the general course of the claim; sixth, the locality of the claim with reference to some natural object or permanent monument whereby the claim can be identified.


