This mining claim the name of which is the St. George Mining Claim stuate on lands belonging to the United States of America, and in which there are valuable mineral deposits, was entered upon and located for the purpose of exploration and purchase by George Scherer, Alexander Bannow, & August Joerss, the undersigned, on the 14th day of May, 1897.


