To all whom it may concern: This mining claim, the name of which is the Bertie Mining Claim, situate on lands belonging to the United States of America, and in which there are valuable mineral deposits, was entered upon and located for the purpose of exploration and purchase by F.A. Biffar, on the 1st day of November, 1897.

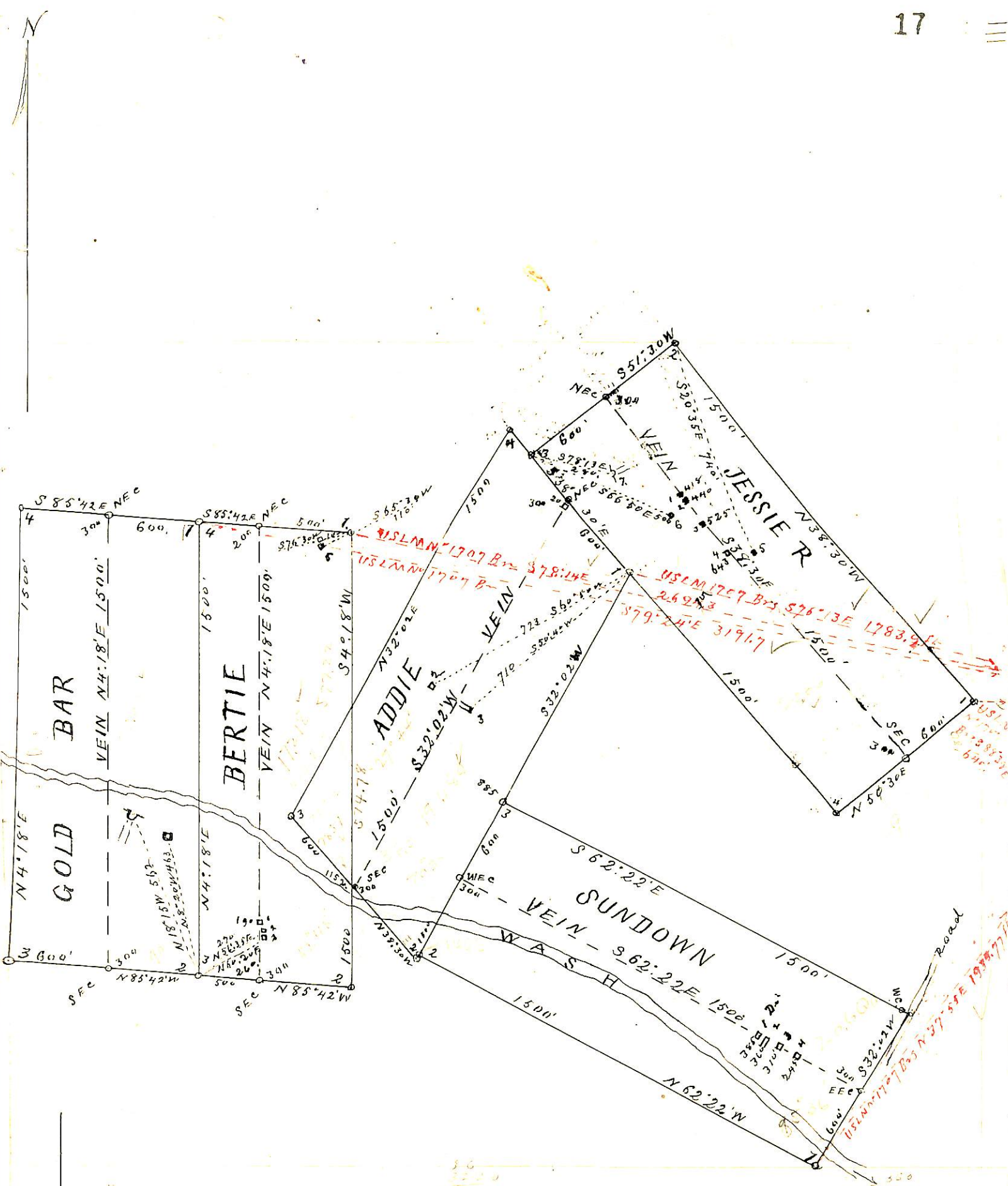
