This survey was made with a Stackpole and Bros. Transit NO. I269. The course was deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct observation checked by an observation on Polaris. steel
The measurements were made with a IOO ft. tape and a 300 ft.steel tape.
On the evening of October Ist. I905 at 6:30 P.M. L.M.T. I set transit over point and observe Polaris, following it to its eastern elongation. I set point on this line and at daylight turn an angle of I°27' left for true meridian. By transit line with angles I connect this line with U.S.L.M. 12170, and check solar observation which I find to be correct.

There being no U.S.L.M. or corner of Government survey within 2 miles of claim, I locate U.S.L.M. on top of the most prominent peak in the vicinity.
