INSTRUMENT:

This survey was made with a Gurley Light Mountain Transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations and checked by a meridian determined by Polaris. The distances were measured with a 100-ft. steel tape.

POLARIS OBSERVATION:
