### An Act Concerning Mines.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Arizona:

That Act No. 42 of the Eighteenth Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Arizona, approved March 5th, 1895, be amended so as to read as follows:

Section 1. Every notice of location of a lode mining claim shall contain: First, the name of the claim located; second, the name of the locator; third, the date of location; fourth, the number of feet in length of said claim and the number of feet claimed on each side of the center of the discovery shaft, lengthwise of the claim; fifth, the general course of the lode, deposit or premises located; eighth with the county Recorder for record within ninety (90) days after same shall have been located.


