

files a supplemental report of improvements, reporting a sufficient amount of improvements upon the claim which now lacks the necessary five hundred dollars' worth of improvements, or a statement establishing conclusively that this credit should be allowed, or a statement showing conclusively that Discovery tunnel No. 1 on the Maine lode is a common improvement for the development of all the claims of this survey and credits a one-sixth interest therein to each of the claims herein, a further and additional certificate will be issued covering the New Hampshire lode.
