This survey was made with a 6 $\frac{1}{4}$ inch Berger Engineer's transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct Solar observation. The distances were measured with a 650 ft. steel tape.

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Report.

The side and end lines of these claims and all tie lines were run direct upon the ground.

The section corner common to Secs. 19 and 30, on the west boundary of T.1 N., R. 15 E., G.&S.R.B.& M., to which tie is given is a schist stone .7 x .8 x 1.0 ft. above the ground marked with two grooves on the south face and four grooves on the north face.
