TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

This Lode Mining Claim, the name of which is the Hilda Mining Claim, situate on lands belonging to the United States of America, and in which there are valuable mineral deposits, was entered on and located for the purposes of exploration and purchase by the Savoy Mining Company (a corporation organized under the laws of the Territory of Arizona), by Bernard Cunniff, General Manager, (a citizen of the United States of America, the undersigned, on the twenty-fifth day of March, 1911.

The length of this claim is fifteen hundred feet, and we claim one hundred ~~and~~ twenty-five feet in a southerly direction and thirteen hundred seventy-five feet in a northerly direction from the centre of the discovery shaft, at which this notice is posted, lengthwise of the claim, together with three hundred feet in width of the surface grounds, on each side of the centre of said claim. The general course of the lode deposit and premises is from the north to the south.

The claim is situated and located in the Tiger Mining District, in Yavapai County in the Territory of Arizona, bounded on the south by the Apache Panther patented mining claim and on the north partly by the Cougar patented mining claim and partly by the Eclipse patented mining claim. Said Hilda claim embraces the Kadish claim, the Eclipse Lode 1st South claim, the Sunbeam claim, and the Virginia claim, all of which claims are recorded, as noted below, in

Beginning at a point on the southerly end line of the Lida lode claim, said point being N. $65^{\circ} 50'$ W. 200 feet from the southeast corner of said Lida lode; thence N. $65^{\circ} 50'$ W. 52.87 feet to an intersection with line 4-1 of the Hilda lode, Survey No. 2908; thence N. $28^{\circ} 12'$ E. along said line 4-1 of the Hilda lode, 453.17 feet to an intersection with the projection of the northerly end line of the Lida lode; thence S. $65^{\circ} 50'$ E. along said projection of the northerly end line of the Lida lode 50.23 feet to a point N. $65^{\circ} 50'$ W. 200 feet from the northeast corner of said Lida lode; thence S. $27^{\circ} 52'$ W., parallel with the easterly side line of the Lida lode, 453 feet to the place of beginning, containing .535 acres.
