# REPORT

The lode line of the location of this claim was run directly on the ground and the several corners established by means of offsets from the lode line. All tie lines were run directly on the ground and all corners and end centers are identical with the location corners and end centers. All post corners were marked with a 1 x 4 in. copper plate having markings stamped on. The errors which exist between this survey and the Irene Lode Lot No. 42 in course and distance of the N. side line are due to errors in the latter. (See \* below)

INSTRUMENT

This survey was made with a light mountain W. & L. E. Gurley transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by an observation on Polaris, June 2 nd. 1911.

The distances were measured with 100 and 600 ft. steel tapes.
